This week I want to highlight the wonderful work of our Pais team as they approach the end of their time with us, at the beginning of July. Gleise from Brazil and Michelle from Germany will soon be returning home. Gabriel from

St Peter's Smithills Dean CE Primary School has benefitted from lessons and lunchtime sessions. The team have visited the school every Thursday and supported the children in the prayer garden, they have led numerous lessons, and provided many opportunities to build relationships.

The team have been leading the Smithills Fellowship Lighthouse group twice a month. They have delivered sessions using the parish-wide Lighthouse resources and seen the children make leaps forward in their faith and bible knowledge.

Each Tuesday evening the team join forces with our Tread leaders for the usual fun and games, discussion time and teaching, which has included a Youth Alpha course. Gleise and Michelle, together with Lucy Hargraves, started a new girl's discipleship group.

Each Monday and Tuesday the team visit Canon Slade CE High School to deliver lunch clubs and support the chaplaincy team.

The Pais team have been a real blessing to many of us,

each week they join our parish staff team to meet, plan and pray together. We thank God for them and pray as they prepare for the next stage in their lives.
