This week a specialist contractor has been safely removing and treating asbestos in St Peter's cellar boiler room. On 5 July work starts on the renovation of the large east window. And on 15 July work starts on the resurfacing of the main driveways and paths, which will include improved disabled parking bays and creating level access through the main entrance into church.
