Rev Alan writes...

After a refreshing week away with Ruth in County Durham, I'm back! I hope those of you who managed a half-term getaway can feel the benefit too. This week, I want to unpack a little about our two new sermon series' which build on



the theme of 'My Church' we have been following this year.

To recap, we have been thinking about what Jesus meant when he said 'My Church' in Matthew 16:18. Because the church did not exist at the time Jesus used these words, we asked what Jesus meant by My **Church?** The word Jesus used for church comes from the Greek word Ecclesia, which means 'called out gathering'. In the first century this would have been like a local council of political representatives who are called out of their local community to meet together it's a picture of church being a place where we are called out of the world to meet before we are called back into the world to carry out God's mission. You could say we Gather on a Sunday and Go on a Monday! and the New Testament shows that in church we are called into a Family – we are Brothers and Sisters, Children of God, and the Household of God. This gave us a definition of church being: **Jesus'** Family on Jesus' Mission. And in recent weeks we have been learning about the mission we are called to.

Building on this in our morning services we are now learning more about **The Relationships of My Church** looking at Parents and Children,



Brothers and Sisters, Husbands and Wives, and Believers and Authorities. *Continued on page 2...*



In parallel, at our parishwide 6.30pm services at St Peter's we are looking at *The Location of My Church* and learning from the Old Testament narratives when God's

people were taken into exile from Israel to a foreign culture in Babylon. Last Sunday Keith Forrester spoke about how being a Christian in today's culture can be like living in exile. You can watch his talk here:

Children and Families Ministry Lead

Could you be the next Children and Families Ministry Lead for our parish?
