Rev Alan writes... My Church

In our teaching this year we have been learning about what Jesus meant when he said "I will build My Church" in Matthew 16:18.



First, that the church belongs to Jesus. Then, that we are a "called out gathering" or ecclesia, but more than that - we are part of a family. And that we are on a mission. I summarised this by defining church as Jesus' Family on Jesus' Mission.

We've used a loop-the-loop symbol to show that we gather and we go.

I thought it would be great to have a piece of artwork to represent this, so I asked the talented artist John Platt from Smithills Fellowship to help.

He's painted the symbol and added the words "My **Church**" on a canvas which I am taking around all our fellowships and inviting everyone to add their thumbprint to the picture.



So far, it's been to St Andrew's and Smithills, next stop is St Peter's this Sunday, and the picture will eventually go on display in our Parish Centre.

So, look out for it and add your thumbprint to show your commitment

to be part of Jesus's Family on Jesus' Mission in St Peter's Parish.
