I am really excited about our **Parish-Wide Vision Service next Sun 6 Oct** and want to use my article this week to tell you more. This is the only service taking place next Sunday, we are cancelling all other services to free everyone up to join together, so please don't turn up at your usual fellowship. Here's what is happening at a glance...

The service takes place at Bolton School, Chorley New Road, BL1 4PA.

Car parking is easy to find, there are car parks at either end of the school site accessible from Tudor Avenue and Dobson Road, off Chorley New Road. Watch out for stewards wearing hi-vis vests!



Disabled access will be via the front entrance of the Riley Centre, parking directly in front of the Riley Centre accessible through the school's central arch. Stewards will be on hand to help.

Twinklers pre-school activities and creche will be in the Riley Centre; we will start the service with our pre-schoolers in the main hall and go out during the first songs.

Lighthouse United Children's session will be the firstever gathering of all three Lighthouse groups from St Peter's, Smithills and Barrow Bridge and our Lighthouse leaders are (*Continued on page 2...*)

Children can go straight to the gym at 11am and will join the service in the main hall near the end. School attendance card stamps will be available as usual. **Lunch** is bring-and-share, picnic style; feel free to bring enough for yourself and extra treats to share. Bolton School has a nut-free policy, so please ensure all food is nut-free. If the weather is nice, we can eat outside or in the Riley Centre which has smart cafe seating with plenty of space. To keep organisation simple, we are not having a central table for food like a buffet, however, extra food can be placed on a table for anyone to help themselves. Please stay for lunch if you can, I hope it will be a great opportunity to get to know people from our four fellowships, and there will be some fun and games to enjoy!

An offering will be taken during the service, and we are hoping to have card machines available for cashless giving.

Volunteers are needed to help with refreshments and stewarding.
