
## Who writes and publishes the guide?

# What is the Origin of Hinduism?

Hinduism, is one of the world's oldest religion, it has its roots and customs dating back more than 4,000 years. Scholars believe it originated between 2300 B.C. and 1500 B.C. in the Indus Valley near modernday Pakistan. Unlike other religions, Hinduism has no single founder; it's a fusion of various beliefs and practices. Today, over one billion followers consider it a "way of life" rather than a single, organized religion. Hindus worship a single deity, Brahma, while recognizing other gods and goddesses. Key concepts include samsara (reincarnation), karma, and the pursuit of moksha (liberation). Hinduism is closely related to other Indian religions such as Buddhism, Sikhism, and Jainism."



# What Does It Mean to be Hindu?

Hinduism and the term 'Hindu' are widely accepted by those who follow this tradition. It encompasses diverse ideas, cultural practices, and a shared sense of identity. Unlike some religions, Hinduism lacks a central authority or fixed criteria for being considered a Hindu. There's no standard process for leaving Hinduism, nor a prescribed method for nonborn Hindus to convert. Being Hindu is an inherent identity, not dependent on specific beliefs, deity worship, or formal conversion.

# What Shapes the Hindu Religion?

Hinduism is shaped by a blend of religious texts, philosophical concepts, cultural practices, and social structures. Key religious texts include the Vedas, Upanishads, and epics like the Mahabharata and Ramayana, which lay the foundation for its rituals and beliefs. Philosophical concepts such as dharma (duty), karma (cause and effect), moksha (liberation), and samsara (the cycle of rebirth) provide a deep spiritual framework.

Cultural practices are integral, encompassing daily rituals, rites of passage, and vibrant festivals like Diwali and Holi. While the influence of the traditional caste system has evolved, it historically played a significant role in shaping social dynamics within Hindu society.

Then if my people who are called by my name will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, I will hear from heaven and will forgive their sins and restore their land.

# And remember...

Hinduism is the 3rd largest religion (next to Christianity and Islam) in the world, yet they remain one of the least-reached with the gospel of Jesus. Throughout history, we've seen that prayer plays a vital role in preparing the way for the spread of the Good News.

Despite this truth, less than 2 percent of cross-cultural missionaries sent by the global church are focused on reaching Hindu communities.

As a result, many Hindus still lack access to the message of Christ. We invite you to pray for Hindus to be blessed, to flourish, and for every individual to encounter the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Spend time in scripture, allowing the Holy Spirit to guide your prayers and reveal His heart for the Hindu world.

# Praying for the Persecuted Body of Christ

In the middle of the Beatitudes, early in his ministry, our Lord Jesus Christ informed his disciples that they would be persecuted — reviled, falsely accused — for his sake. This might have seemed rather unfathomable to his early followers, as Jesus was just starting his ministry among them, and likewise, it may seem incredulous to us in this current day. But the Body of Christ is being persecuted — attacked, arrested, beaten, and killed — for His name's sake, just as Jesus foretold, in places like North Korea, China, Iran, Pakistan, Afghanistan, Nigeria, Somalia, Sudan and . . . India.

Christians in India have often suffered persecution since Independence from England in 1947, but usually these were more isolated incidents. However, in recent years, India, as well as Nepal and other nations, have seen an unprecedented rise in the persecution of the Body of Christ in what appears to be an intentional and coordinated effort to eliminate Christians from the entire country. Over the last 10 years, we have seen thousands of attacks on churches, pastors and church members; beatings and killings; and false arrests and imprisonment, even forced re-conversion.

And while the media does not carry much of this story, we shudder in horror at the reports and pictures that do trickle through, and often wonder, "What can we do when the Body of Christ, of which we are also members, suffers such terrible persecution?" We see our answer in the early Church, even when Peter had been arrested and imprisoned. What did they do? In Acts 12:5, we read that "Peter was

therefore kept in prison, but constant prayer was offered to God for him by the church." Even when Peter was miraculously delivered from prison by the angels, "He came to the house of Mary, ... where many were gathered together praying." (12:12) The early Christfollowers, when faced with the persecution and imprisonment of one of their leaders, gathered together, dropped to their knees, and cried out to God for his deliverance.

Following the example of the early Church, we must be in fervent prayer for others in the Body of Christ, especially those that come from Hindu backgrounds, as these HBBs face the most extreme persecution from their own families and communities, in India, Nepal, and other nations. We encourage you to pray that God may continue to provide for their needs and protect them as they grow in their faith in Him. Additionally, we must remember and pray for those who have left their original communities, perhaps displaced because of their faith in Christ, that they may find solace, Christian community and learn more of the matchless love of God the Father. And pray that they may learn, as we all must, to do as our Lord commanded:

Blessed are those who are persecuted For righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Blessed are you when they revile and persecute you, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely for My sake.

# HERE ARE SOME KEY STATISTICS OF THE HINDU PEOPLE

#### GEOGRAPHIC DISTRIBUTION

- India: The largest population of Hindus, with around 966 million adherents, making up about 79.8% of the country's population.
- Nepal: Over 23 million Hindus, constituting about 81.3% of the population.
- Bangladesh: Around 13 million Hindus, roughly 8-10% of the population.
- Indonesia: Particularly in Bali, with about 4 million Hindus, around 1.7% of the population.
- Pakistan: Approximately 3.5 million Hindus, about 1.85% of the population.
- **Sri Lanka:** Around 2.5 million Hindus, approximately 12.6% of the population.
- United States: About 2.5 million Hindus, around 0.7% of the population.
- **United Kingdom:** Approximately 1.5 million Hindus, roughly 2.3% of the population.

#### CASTE DISTRIBUTION IN INDIA

- **Brahmins:** Traditionally priests and scholars, estimated at around 5-6% of the population.
- **Kshatriyas:** Historically warriors and rulers, around 4-5%.
- Vaishyas: Traditionally merchants and landowners, about 7-8%.
- Shudras: Historically laborers and service providers, making up the majority, around 40-45%.
- Dalits (Scheduled Castes): Outside the traditional varna system, constituting about 16-17%.
- Adivasis (Scheduled Tribes): Indigenous people, around 8-9%.

# **Praying For Hindu Families**

The structure of Hindu family life is intricately woven with religious, cultural, and social customs that define their daily routines and values. Central to this familial identity is a strong commitment to family unity, reverence for elders, and dedicated participation in religious rituals. For example, it is common for extended families to live together in a joint family system, promoting intergenerational support and closeness—a tradition that is both cultural and practical. Daily spiritual practices, such as puja (worship), are a staple in most Hindu homes, with nearly 77% of Hindu families engaging in puja daily according to a recent survey.

Additionally, major festivals like Diwali, celebrated by lighting lamps and exchanging gifts to symbolize the victory of light over darkness, play a significant role in strengthening familial and community ties. This blend of deep-rooted traditions and religious observances underscores the hierarchical yet closely bonded nature of Hindu family structures.

As the world evolves, some Hindu families are beginning to explore new spiritual paths, seeking to exchange their traditional beliefs for the knowledge of a loving Savior, Jesus Christ. This journey of faith can be both challenging and transformative, especially for those deeply rooted in their religious traditions. Hindu Background Believers often face significant personal sacrifices as they dedicate their lives to reaching out to their families and communities with the message of the Gospel. Their commitment to sharing the love of Christ and bringing others into covenant with the true and living God of the Bible is both courageous and vital. It is essential that we pray for these brave individuals, asking for God's protection, strength, and guidance as they spread the Gospel to Hindu families. Our prayers can support their efforts, asking that their message be received with open hearts and that they be empowered to continue their mission amidst the challenges they face.



# Praying that Pradeep's Faith Doesn't Cause Family Struggles...

Pradeep was born in a Hindu family in India, and for a period of his childhood lived on the grounds of a Christian seminary in India where his parents worked as support staff. After finishing college, Pradeep moved overseas as a global scholar, where he came to faith in Jesus. Some of his siblings have come to follow Jesus as well, but not his parents or his older brother. In fact, his older brother accuses Pradeep that, "because of Jesus you have abandoned our family!" Pray that relationships between Pradeep and his brother and parents would be restored and that his family members would come to faith in Jesus.





Pray for the Hindu families that they will seek the truth, that Hindus may encounter the loving Savior, Jesus Christ, and find new meaning in His grace and love.

Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit.

# A Closer Look at the Indian/Hindu Diaspora

In a North American city, a community of Indian immigrants gather at a local temple, united by chants that resonate with the traditions of their homeland. This group represents the Indian/Hindu diaspora, which comprises individuals who have left India for various reasons including better economic opportunities, education, escape from rigid social structures,

and the pursuit of personal freedom. Importantly, many also aim to preserve their cultural and religious identity in a foreign setting, where they can practice their beliefs freely without conforming to majority norms. However, not all members of the diaspora have migrated by choice; some, like Hindu Background Believers, have been forced to flee due to persecution. For example, Ramesh, a young convert from Odisha, faced severe threats and violence from his community, prompting him to seek safety in Europe where he could freely practice Christianity and rebuild his life, illustrating the difficult sacrifices many make for religious freedom. His story is a poignant example of the sacrifices many HBB make, leaving their homeland not just in search of a better life, but in pursuit of the basic right to worship in peace.

# The Hindu Religion ...... HOW CAN WE Praying For Hindus to Know Jehovah God

Understanding the vast and intricate belief system of Hinduism is essential for grasping the profound spiritual needs of its followers and the great importance of praying for them. While there are said to be 330 million gods within this religion, all these deities are seen as manifestations of a single ultimate reality, known as Brahma. This complex belief structure can create a spiritual environment where individuals may seek divine favor through numerous forms, yet still yearn for a deeper connection with the one true God. Recognizing the diversity and depth of these religious beliefs underscores the critical need to pray for the Hindu people, that they might encounter the love and truth of Jesus Christ, the embodiment of God's grace and the path to eternal salvation.

# **Number of Religions Within Hinduism**

Hinduism is not a monolithic religion but rather a broad umbrella term encompassing a variety of religious traditions, practices, and philosophies. Within Hinduism, there are several major sects and traditions, including:

- 1. Vaishnavism: Worship of Vishnu and his avatars like Krishna and Rama.
- 2. Shaivism: Worship of Shiva as the supreme god.
- 3. Shaktism: Worship of the Goddess. particularly in forms like Durga and Kali.
- 4. SmartIsm: A more liberal and inclusive tradition that worships multiple deities, including Vishnu, Shiva, Shakti, Ganesh, and Surva, considering them all as manifestations of Brahman.

As deeply ingrained as these beliefs and practices are, there is a need to pray for the Hindu people to have their spiritual eyes opened to the truth of the Gospel. According to Ephesians 1:17, we ask that "the God of our Lord Jesus Christ. the Father of glory, may give them the Spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him," enlightening their hearts to understand the hope found in Christ. Through prayer, we can intercede for the Hindu people, asking that their deep-rooted religious culture be transformed by the light of Christ, leading them to experience the fullness of God's love and salvation.

# The Challenges of the Christian Persecution in India

In the 2023 executive summary of the Religious Liberty Commission of the Evangelical Fellowship of India, the annual report titled \*"Faith Under Fire: Documenting Targeted Hate and Violence Against the Christian Community in India (2023)"\* recorded a staggering 601 incidents of anti-Christian Violence. These disturbing events highlight the growing hostility faced by Christians in India. Below, we have outlined these 601 incidents, and over the next five pages of our prayer guide, we have identified five key areas of concern for you to cover in prayer. We invite you to engage with these pressing issues and lift them before the Lord as we intercede for our brothers and sisters in Christ.

# Praying For Hindu Background Believers Serving God with Anti-Conversion Laws

In 2015, Tarun Vijay, a Member of Parliament in India's Upper House, emphasized the importance of maintaining a Hindu majority in the country. He expressed concern that the Hindu population had dropped below 80 percent for the first time in India's history, stating that measures needed to be taken to address this decline. Vijay's comments reflect a nationalist perspective increasingly common and influential in India, as well as in other parts of South and Southeast Asia. This viewpoint considers conversions away from the dominant religions—such as Hinduism in India and Nepal, or Buddhism in Myanmar and Bhutan—as threats to national identity. In response, these countries, or specific states within India, have enacted laws that prohibit religious conversion under ambiguous terms like 'inducement' or 'fraudulent circumstances.' These laws are often applied selectively, effectively preventing conversions from majority to minority religions. The presence of anti-conversion laws tends to empower nationalist religious extremists, legitimizing their persecution of minority religious communities.

# Praying For Christians in Nepal Navigating Anti-Conversion Laws

Persecution in Nepal is a growing concern as the Christian population increases in the predominantly Hindu nation. A recent article by the Global Press Journal highlights the plight of Pastor Hari Tamang, who faced false charges of child trafficking and attempted conversions after offering shelter to children from a closing facility. Although the trafficking charges were dropped, Pastor Tamang continues to battle allegations of trying to convert the children.

Nepal's laws permit the free practice of religion but prohibit converting others, creating societal tensions. The Christian community in Nepal maintains that sharing their faith aligns with Christ's teachings, emphasizing that conversion is a personal choice and not to be imposed. Despite this, accusations of forceful conversions persist. The growth of Christianity in Nepal has been rapid, with estimates suggesting there are now between 2 to 3 million Christians and 10,000 to 12,000 churches

nationwide, reflecting a significant increase in the Christian demographic.

# Sita's Story

Sita is a young woman from a rural Nepalese village who after converting to Christianity from Hinduism through personal conviction, she was accused of coercion and arrested for sharing her faith, leading to intense interrogation and social rejection. Her family disowned her under community pressure, and she was ostracized, facing significant legal and social challenges. Sita's experience highlights the urgent need for prayer and advocacy for religious freedom for Hindu Background Believers in Nepal, where practicing their chosen faith can lead to severe consequences.

# Praying For Christian House Churches Persecuted But Not Forsaken!

Christian house churches in predominantly Hindu nations like India and Nepal face severe persecution, significantly influenced by Hindu nationalist agendas and strict regulations on religious gatherings. In India, 2023 saw over 500 attacks on Christian communities, with many targeting house church gatherings through raids by local authorities and extremist groups, resulting in arrests and the disruption of worship services. Moreover, the systematic closure of house churches forces believers to meet secretly to avoid detection and harassment. Statistics indicate that about 60% of Christian congregations in Nepal have encountered some form of harassment or legal trouble. These situations underline the critical need for ongoing prayer and support for these communities, as they courageously continue their faith practices under such oppressive conditions.

#### PASTOR HANOK'S STORY

Pastor Hanok reports, a Christian woman named Sadhya invited several church members, including himself, to a prayer meeting. Before the meeting, Sadhya received permission from her Hindu landlord to hold the meeting in her home at around noon, only minutes after the Christians gathered at Sadhya's home, 15 extremists broke into the house and attacked the Christians with wooden clubs and sticks. The landlord joined the extremists and helped drag Pastor Hanok out of the house, where he was further assaulted and threatened with being set on fire.

"I was panicked as all of this was going on," Pastor Hanok recalled. "For 30 minutes, the attack continued, but we eventually managed to run in different directions and reached the police station."



As a result of the attack, three Christians were seriously injured, and Pastor Hanok's car was damaged. A Christian man named Janaiah had his eardrum completely shattered, and a Christian woman named Annamma lost six teeth.

# Praying For Hindu Background ••••• Believers Pressured to Re-Convert to Hinduism - "Ghar Wapsi"?

# What is Ghar Wapsi:

Ghar Wapsi (meaning "Homecoming" in Hindi) is a controversial term used in India referring to the process of converting individuals from Christianity or Islam back to Hinduism. Proponents of Ghar Wapsi argue that it is a way to return people to their "original" cultural and religious heritage, while critics argue that it is often carried out under coercion, pressure, or even intimidation.

In several Hindu-majority nations, particularly in India, Christians face increasing pressure to participate in Ghar Wapsi, a controversial initiative aimed at reconverting them to Hinduism through social coercion, economic incentives, or threats of violence. Reports have emerged of Christian families being offered financial support or public recognition to renounce their faith, while others have faced threats of physical harm or social ostracism for resisting these ceremonies. Such coercive practices underscore the vulnerability of religious minorities and the broader issue of religious intolerance. Notably, in Uttar Pradesh in 2022, local Hindunationalist groups held high-profile Ghar Wapsi events targeting Christian communities, forcing reconversion under intense public scrutiny. Similar pressures have been reported in rural areas, where Christians are forced into public renunciations of their faith. These developments highlight the severe pressures and risks Christians endure in these regions, underscoring the critical need for prayers for their protection, strength, and the courage to maintain their faith amidst such challenges, as well as for divine intervention to safeguard their religious freedom and dignity.

# The State of Uttar Pradesh ····· Treasures in Jars of Clay!

## **About Uttar Pradesh**

Uttar Pradesh, located in northern India, is the most populous state in the country with over 240 million residents as of 2023. The state covers an area of about 243,286 square kilometers (93,933 square miles), making it one of India's largest states by land area. Uttar Pradesh is predominantly Hindu, with around 80% of the population identifying as Hindu, while Muslims make up approximately 19%. Christians and other religious minorities constitute less than 1% of the population. The state has a significant rural population, with agriculture being the primary occupation for many residents.

# The need for prayer...

Uttar Pradesh is one of the most challenging regions for religious minorities in India, and Hindu Background Believers endure severe persecution for their faith in Jesus. The hostility they face is often severe, fueled by societal and institutional pressures. In 2023, for example, a group of Hindu Background Believers in a village was brutally attacked by a mob after a prayer meeting. The attackers accused them of proselytizing and vandalized their homes, resulting in injuries and trauma. In another incident, a Christian pastor and his family were forcibly evicted and accused of illegal conversion activities by local authorities, leaving them to flee for safety and abandon their livelihood. These incidents underscore the dire circumstances Hindu Background Believers in Uttar Pradesh face, marked by violence and discrimination.

From 2020 to 2024, Uttar Pradesh has seen a concerning rise in anti-Christian persecution, fueled by extremist groups and nationalist ideologies. Here are several significant statistics and trends:

- 1. 2020: The Evangelical Fellowship of India (EFI) recorded 70 incidents of anti-Christian violence in Uttar Pradesh. These incidents ranged from violent assaults to disruptions of religious gatherings.
- 2. 2022: Reports highlighted a notable increase in physical assaults and social ostracism of Christians in rural areas. The "Ghar Wapsi" movement in Uttar Pradesh, aimed at "reconverting" Christians to Hinduism, gained momentum during this period.
- 4. 2023: Christian persecution continued to escalate with \*\*multiple attacks on house churches\*\* and believers, particularly those from Dalit and Adivasi communities. In one report, \*\*32 violent incidents\*\* against Christians were recorded during the first half of 2023 alone.



Pray for protection over Christians in Uttar Pradesh, that God would be their refuge and strength in these difficult times. That they are surrounded with God's peace and fortify their hearts with courage to stand firm in their faith despite the threats and violence they encounter.

# The State of Odisha (Orissa) · Pressed But Not Crushed

#### About Odisha (Orissa)

Odisha, located on the eastern coast of India, is home to approximately 46 million people as of 2023. The state covers an area of about 155,707 square kilometers (60,119 square miles).

Odisha's population is predominantly Hindu, with around 94% identifying with the Hindu faith, while Christians make up about 2.8% of the population, and Muslims account for approximately 2.2%. Odisha is known for its rich cultural heritage, ancient temples, and diverse tribal communities, with about 22% of the population belonging to Scheduled Tribes.

# The Urgent Need for Prayer for believers in Odisha

In the state of Odisha, Hindu
Background Believers face significant
persecution for their faith in Jesus,
encountering hostility from their
communities and local authorities amid
longstanding religious tensions. Many
have suffered violence, social ostracism,
and economic difficulties due to
their conversion.

The is a great need to pray for believers in Odisha, India, here are a few stories:

## The Attack of the Kandhamal District of Odisha:

The 2007-2008 pogrom in the Kandhamal District of Orissa (now Odisha) was one of the worst incidents of anti-Christian violence in India's recent history. During this period, Hindu extremist groups attacked Christian communities, leading to the deaths of over 100 people, the destruction of around 300 churches, and the displacement of more than 50,000 Christians. Thousands of homes were destroyed, and many Christians were forced to live in relief camps for months due to the widespread violence.

#### **Eviction of Christian Families in South Odisha:**

In July 2024, seven families who had converted from their tribal religion to Christianity were evicted from a forested village in south Odisha. The tribal village council forced them out, leaving them without proper food or shelter during the heavy monsoon season. Despite complaints to local authorities, no action has been taken to address this injustice...

## Attack on Christian Homes in Jharsuguda District:

On October 7, 2023, religious fanatics attacked more than seven Christian homes in a village called Hirma in Jharsuguda district, Odisha. Religious fanatics targeted more than seven Christian homes, violently dragging families out of their houses and beating them mercilessly, including women and children.

These stories underscore the unwavering faithfulness of the Lord in sustaining His people through trials, providing them with strength, hope, and a tangible sense of His presence, even under the most trying circumstances.

Pray for the HIndu Background Believers in Odisha to continue trusting God as their rock, fortress, and deliverer. Surround them with Your shield and grant them strength to endure the hardships they face.

# The State of Manipur, India... Persecuted, Not Forsaken!

# **About Manipur**

Manipur, located in northeastern India, is a state with a population of approximately 3.2 million people as of the latest census. It covers an area of around 22,327 square kilometers (8,621 square miles). The population of Manipur is religiously and ethnically diverse, with a majority being the Meitei people (predominantly Hindu), and the Naga and Kuki-Mizo hill tribes, most of whom are Christian. The religious composition includes Hindus making up about 51% of the population, Christians approximately 41%, and Muslims around 8%.

#### A Call to Prayer for Believers in Manipur...

In the state of Manipur in northeastern India, Hindu Background Believers endure considerable persecution due to their faith, exacerbated by the region's complex ethnic and religious dynamics which often lead to tensions and violence against religious minorities. The ongoing persecution underscores the urgent need for prayer and support for the Hindu Background Believers community in Manipur. It is vital to pray for their safety, the cessation of hostility, and for divine intervention to foster peace and tolerance in the region.

# **Recent Violence and Attacks:**

In May 2023, tensions between the Kuki tribe (predominantly Christian) and the majority-Hindu Meitei people escalated into violence. Over 350 churches and church properties were burned, and and more than 200 Christians have lost their lives in the ongoing violence.

The pro-Hindu government's decision to give additional land and benefits to the Meitei people, coupled with the eviction of Christian Kukis from their ancestral land, triggered great violence.

Believers have been beaten, threatened, and forced to renounce their faith. Thousands have been displaced, and the situation remains volatile, with attacks on Christian villages even in the last week of September 2024.

Pray for our brothers and sisters in Manipur who face persecution for their faith in Jesus Christ. Pray for their protection, and that God would cover them with His wings and provide them a safe haven from the violence and threats they endure. May God strengthen their spirits and grant them resilience to continue in their faith journey despite the hostility they face.

In an article published on August 14, 2024, by Christianwalk.com columnist Milton Q. covers the urgent appeal from Christian leaders across the United States.

"We invite you to stand in solidarity with believers advocating for immediate action in support of Hindu Background Believers, particularly in India. Join us in prayer, united in our hope for the amendment of the oppressive laws that afflict persecuted Christians in India."

Over 300 Christian leaders in the United States, including denominational leaders, are calling on the nation's State Department to designate India as a "Country of Particular Concern" due to its persecution of Christians. According to The Christian Post, the Christian leaders say that persecution of religious minorities in India grew worse since Modi's regime began in 2014.

"This surge in violence is propelled by a Hindu ethnonationalist or Hindutva supremacist political ideology, which conflates a militant Hindu ideology with Indian citizen identities," the letter, organized by the Federation of Indian-American Christian Organizations in North America, states. "As a result, both the Hindu religion and India's Constitutional secular democracy have been severely distorted, leading to alarming levels of state-sanctioned violence against Christians, lower-caste Dalits, and other religious minorities both on the streets and within state structures."

The letter was signed by church leaders of various denominations, including 18 bishops, three archbishops, numerous clergy members, and leaders from Christian and theological organizations. It also refers to a January 2024 petition signed by more than 3,000 ecumenical Christian leaders in India, denouncing the Indian government's persecution of religious minorities.

The letter also cites a report by the United Christian Forum, which notes a significant rise in attacks on Christians, from 127 incidents in 2014 to 720 in 2023. As pointed out in the letter, over 65,000 people being displaced in Manipur, and more than 350 churches were destroyed or damaged since May 2023 due to the persecution.




