Rev Alan writes... My Church Commitment – To Meet



Last week I wrote about our commitment to **Give** as part of our Parish Vision to grow in commitment to church: "Jesus' Family on Jesus' Mission". Over the coming weeks in our morning services, we are learning more about what this means in our five areas of commitment to **Give**, **Meet**, **Serve**, **Baptise and Pray**. This week I am writing about our commitment to **Meet**.



We see in Acts 2:46 that the early church right from its beginnings met in large and small groups (the temple courts and people's homes). It is wellproven that if you want to grow as a Christian you need to be

part of a small group (Life Group, Connect Group, Home Group). A good place to start is our Alpha Course, from there you can progress into a small group. Small groups are places where we can learn from God's word and work out what it means for our lives today, they are also places where we care for one another, pray and support each other when we go through life's challenges.

When I first became a Christian in my mid-twenties, I joined a home group at my local church in Salford. I made great friendships, learned what it really means to be a follower of Jesus, and grew so much. I really loved the experience!

Our vision is to increase the number of small groups we have across the parish, and I want to encourage people to set up and lead new groups, especially if you've been a Christian for a good few years and you've got a lot to offer others. Over the next five years our vision is to increase from seven groups to thirty, and from two young people's discipleship groups to ten.
