Welcome to Advent! In addition to our regular weekly services, we have some fantastic services, events and outreach opportunities coming up during Advent, read on to find out more...

Next **Sat 7 Dec, 12.30-3.30pm is Smithills Christmas Market** on
Redcar Road. It's a festive feast
with heaps of Christmas crafts,
tasty treats and marvellous music
for everyone to enjoy whilst raising
funds for Urban Outreach.



Sun 8 Dec, 10am is Smithills Farm Nativity – a fun way to join in the Christmas story with real animals and children, what could possibly go wrong! This year is the first year we are calling it a parish-wide event and encouraging anyone to go.

Fri 13 Dec, 6.30pm at Barrow Bridge Mission we gather for an evening of carol singing around Barrow Bridge Village, accompanied by a brass ensemble, and followed by seasonal refreshments at the Mission. Everyone is welcome for what is a wonderful atmospheric occasion.

Sun 15 Dec, 10.30am at St Peter's is our first-ever Lighthouse United Nativity where children from Lighthouse groups across the parish will be uniting to act out the Christmas story in a highly entertaining and creative way! Smithills Fellowship have cancelled their morning service so that everyone can join in.

Also on **Sun 15 Dec, 2pm at Smithills Hall Chapel** there is a reflective service for anyone looking for a quieter opportunity to draw close to God in worship.



Wed 18 Dec, 7.30pm at Heaton Cricket Club is a 'Barrel of Carols' a spirit-filled singalong evening of music and good cheer, led by our very own musicians and with a Christmas message from the Vicar!

Sun 22 Dec, 6.30pm at St Peter's is our annual parish-wide candlelit carol service with a full choir and brass ensemble. This has become a popular service which follows the format of 9 lessons (bible readings) and carols that retell the whole Christmas story in words and music.



Christmas Eve, 4pm at St Peter's is a special family Christingle service. It is a short and fun-packed service where we all get to construct our own Christingles and join together singing lively Christmas songs and getting in the mood for Christmas Day.

Christmas Eve, 11.30pm at St Peter's is our annual Midnight Communion service where we recall the birth of our saviour on this most holy of nights.

Then on **Christmas Day** we have a wonderful celebration of Jesus' birth at all our fellowships across the parish, St Andrew's and Barrow Bridge fellowships celebrate together at a special joint service at Barrow Bridge Mission.
