Sun 22 Dec, 6.30pm at St Peter's is our annual parish-wide candlelit carol service with a full choir and brass ensemble. This has become a popular service which follows the format of 9 lessons (bible readings) and carols that retell the whole Christmas story in words and music.

PRAYER from Carolyn Rigby on behalf of Barrow Bridge Mission

This Advent I am reading daily reflections from a book called "Mary's Voice". My youngest daughter suggested that we both read it with her elder sister, so some days we post a comment on what thoughts and ideas have come to us as we have completed that day's reflection in our family chat. This book has really made me take a closer look at Mary; in most nativities Mary is a silent and passive figure but if we consider just how influential she was in the Christian faith, that is really a WOW moment. It must have been such a shock for a young, poor unmarried woman to have been visited by an Angel and be told she was going to have a baby, yet not once did she complain. Instead, she accepted what she was being told, she said "Yes!". Mary's yes changed the world forever and allowed God to come into the world.

Heavenly Father, we give thanks for choosing Mary to be your "yes" person and through her, for sending your son to be with us in the world. During this Advent season, inspire us by Mary's example, that by our daily answers of "Yes" we may build a community of loving kindness and make you known throughout the world. We ask this in your mighty name. Amen
