Rev Alan writes... Hello from Uganda!



The Anglican Youth Fellowship (AYF) choir was established 40 years ago by the Anglican Church of Uganda to help reach out to young people in more culturally relevant ways. When AYF started, worship was old-fashioned and the AYF brought a revolution using guitars, drums and electronic instruments. They also specialised in adapting styles of music to represent the rich diversity of tribal cultures across the country. It proved a powerful mix which caught the attention of many including the Church Mission Society (CMS) who, in 1993, facilitated the AYF's first international mission visit to the UK. It was during this visit that I first encountered them; I was a young Cub Scout leader, and I was blown away by their joy and commitment, so much so that I committed my life to Christ. The best decision I ever made!

So, it is a special privilege to be in Uganda to share in their 40th anniversary. It's been a packed programme of activities and rehearsals. I joined the AYF family day which united members past and present to celebrate, share stories, pray and worship. I've spent time catching up with many of the AYF members, some of whom I had not seen for over 30 years. I am excited to see many of their children following in their footsteps.



Ugandan Family TV regularly feature AYF in a weekly show. They recorded a special edition featuring myself

Uganda is an incredible country, being on the equator means it have 12 hours of daylight and it is summer all year round. This means it is always bustling with energy with people and animals outdoors everywhere.

The AYF treated me to a very special experience – a trip to Murchison Falls National Park, it's the biggest

park in Uganda covering over 1,500 square miles and is home to over 144 mammal species including lions, elephants, buffalo, and Rothschild's giraffes. It also has the most powerful waterfall in the



world, the pressure is so great that the ground trembles around it! I will have lots of photos and stories to share when I return, so watch out!

Climax of the AYF anniversary celebrations will be a series of services followed by a huge concert at All Saints Cathedral in Kampala at 3pm local time this Sunday, that's 12noon in UK - it will last for several hours, and it will be possible to watch on live-stream. We will try to share a link when it's available.

I'll be back home late Monday and look forward to seeing you all, but not so much the cold weather!




into Algiers. Ask the Lord to enable them to build up positive relationships with the community there, and to guide them to the right place to live and that their residence
