From starting in Manchester over 30 years ago, The Message Trust is now a worldwide movement which passionately shares the love of Jesus in words and actions with the hardest-to-reach young people and communities.

I worked for The Message for 7 years before starting my ordination training; it



was an amazing experience which radically impacted my understanding of faith and my passion for evangelism.

The Message builds up evangelists all over the world in their Advance Groups, equips and trains young people on their Message School of Evangelism, serves communities through Eden and Community Groceries, reaches those in prison with the hope of God, supports those with barriers to employment through Christ-centred enterprise, and declares the love of Jesus through schools work - they are seeing lives transformed as people discover their true identity in Christ.

This Sunday, we have an amazing line-up of worldclass speakers at all our services, I am convinced you will be inspired and encouraged in your faith, it's also a great opportunity to invite your friends to come to church. Climax of the day will be our Parishwide 6.30pm service with Andy Hawthorne.

Andy Hawthorne OBE will be speaking at St Peter's 10.30am, and our Parish-wide 6.30pm service at St Peter's. Andy is the Founder and Global CEO of the



Message Trust. He is a worldrenowned speaker, evangelist and author with a wealth of learning from decades of mission into the toughest communities, prisons and schools across the globe. Andy's passion, experience and life-long walk with Jesus will inspire, equip

and empower you to take up the call of reaching the hardest-to-reach people for Jesus.

Sam Ward will be speaking at Smithills Fellowship 10am. Sam is the UK CEO of The Message. He has a



particular passion for urban mission, being actively involved in the Eden Network for over 23 years and now rolling out an exciting new project 'Proximity' whose vision is to resource and support urban missionaries

around the UK and beyond. Sam continues to live in the deprived neighbourhood of Openshaw with his family, where his days as Eden Team Leader started.

Ben heads up Advance: The Message Evangelists Movement, committed to the equipping and multiplication of preaching evangelists in the UK and beyond. As award-winning DJ Galactus Jack, he also performs and preaches the gospel around the world.

Our darkness may be overwhelming at times, our Treasures may be many things, but God's love and light are constant. Two books I've recently read have struck a chord. '*The Boy, the Mole, the Fox and the Horse' by Charlie Mackesy* is beautiful, written for difficult times and all ages - every page holds a new treasure, how everything we do makes a difference and whoever we are we are of value, also how to love, how to care, how to be. '*I Haven't Been Entirely Honest with You' by Miranda Hart*. No spoilers... Her journey through difficulties and pain, each chapter taking a step at a time but in every part of the journey finding Treasures. Both books reflect God's involvement with, and in, everything we are and do. His light, his love. One last treasure straight from God. During one of our family services, a young child after joining at the front dancing and waving ribbons, ran back to her daddy who swept her up in his arms, kissed and hugged her - an absolute picture of God's love. God says "I will give you Treasures of darkness, and hidden riches of secret places, that you may know that it is I who calls you by your name". Amen
