Rev Alan writes... Smithills Vision Sunday

This Sunday, I am delighted to be taking part in the annual Vision Sunday for Smithills Fellowship. It's another opportunity to look back and thank God for the marvellous achievements of the last year and look forward to all that is ahead this year.



Coming up, we have Vision Sundays at Barrow Bridge on Sun 23 Feb, and for the first time St Peter's is on Sun 2 March. If you are regularly committed to any of these fellowships, please consider joining your leadership team - you can speak to myself or any of your leaders to explore the idea.

Baptism and Confirmation Opportunities

We are offering two opportunities at our Parishwide 6.30pm services at St Peter's.

On **Sunday 16 March at 6.30pm** we are offering the opportunity for anyone to



be confirmed. Confirmation is a special church service in which a person confirms the promises that were made when they were baptised. If you were baptised at a christening when you were a child, your parents and godparents made these promises on your behalf. As a young person or adult, you may be ready to affirm these promises for yourself and commit your life to following Jesus Christ. At a Confirmation service, you make these promises for yourself. Your friends and family as well as your Christian family at St Peter's will be there to promise to support and pray for you. The Bishop of Bolton, Matthew Porter, will lay his hands on your head and ask God's Holy Spirit to give you the strength and commitment to live God's way for the rest of your life.

Changes to Canon Slade Admissions Policy from September 2026



Canon Slade's Admission Policy has been changed. Following the required statutory consultation, it has been agreed that for entry from **September 2026** onwards:

- The number of years of required church attendance will reduce to 3 years
- The number of church attendances counted will reduce to 26
- Deanery points will reduce from currently 20 points to 5

One point will be awarded for each week of attendance at worship (up to a maximum points' allocation of 26 per year) for each of the parent and child over a three-year period from the child being in Year 3. Points will therefore be allocated as follows: Child awarded from 0 to 78 points; Parent awarded from 0 to 78 points. Maximum 156 points for church attendance. Five further points will be given for residence in Bolton Deanery (or any equivalent area if the Bolton Deanery is replaced in any future church re-organisation). The maximum points will be 161. Stamps for attendance in our parish will therefore, from now on, be needed for children in Years 3, 4 and 5 only, with 26 being the maximum number of stamps counted in one year.

These changes recognise the decline in church attendance over many years. Additionally, family life has changed significantly with more children now committed to Sunday morning activities and families finding it too challenging to achieve 45 weeks' attendance. In fact, the Church of England now defines "regular" attendance as once a month. The school has been acutely aware for some years that many Christian families who would wish to send their children to Canon Slade do not apply, fearful that if they do not put Canon Slade first on the form they will not get a place, and that it is too risky for them to put Canon Slade first on the form if they have fewer points. At present, the school no longer has enough church families to fill the 300 places available. Hopefully these changes will give more church-going families confidence to apply to Canon Slade. Even allowing for these changes, Canon Slade still has the highest expectation of church attendance of any church school in the region.
