It's Holy Week!

Starting with Palm Sunday, we remember Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem when the crowds shouted 'Hosanna', which means 'He saves'. But it wasn't long until the shouting changed to 'Crucify him' and triumph turned to tragedy as Jesus is arrested, flogged and killed on a Roman cross. Three days later, he is resurrected from the dead and wins a mighty victory over death and sin. So, we join with a new shout of 'Halleluiah, He is risen!' on Easter Sunday, the greatest day in history.


