Rev Alan writes...

I am full of hope and expectation that this year will be a breakthrough year of building for the parish as we strengthen and expand our staff team. This week I want to update you on a few developments.

Firstly, I am excited to announce that very soon we will be advertising for a **Youth and Children's**Ministry Lead. It's a full-time role for someone to oversee and develop our youth and children's ministry across the parish.

We will also be advertising for a full-time **Associate Minister**. This will be an ordained member of the clergy who will serve alongside me to help lead our parish. I am pleased that the diocese has agreed to purchase a new home for this person. Please let me know if you are aware of any houses with room for an office up for sale.

Phil Weaver, one of our Churchwardens, will be stepping down at our APCM (Annual Parochial Church Meeting) on 1 May. Phil has done an outstanding job as warden and I'm sorry to see him step down, but I do recognise it is right for him, and I know he will continue to use his gifts to serve in other ways. This means we are on the lookout for a new warden. I'd like to use this as an opportunity to reassess and simplify the role, reducing the workload and expanding the opportunity for more people to serve in this way. Anyone from any fellowship is eligible, it doesn't need to be someone at St Peter's church fellowship. So, if you'd like to explore the idea, please contact me and I'd love to talk it through.

As we continue through Lent please pray, asking God to raise up the right people for these important roles.

In our morning sermon series, we continue to learn about Jesus the Forgiver. At our parish-wide 6.30pm services in the lead-up to Easter, we will be looking in John's gospel at the stories of Jesus' anointing at Bethany and his entry into Jerusalem as king on Palm Sunday.

Electoral Roll Deadline TODAY!

If you haven't yet completed an Electoral Roll (ER) form, please do it today. After today, a completely new ER is being prepared and even if you have been on it in previous years, if you don't complete a new form, you will no longer be on it. The new ER will take effect from next Sun, 13 Apr.

Every 6 years a completely new ER is created, and 2025 is one of these years. This is the nearest thing to membership we have in the church and means that you have voting rights to play your part in electing our PCC leadership team and officers. It also has a bearing on our status as a parish when allocating clergy and diocese resources.

Everyone on our current ER that wishes to remain so must apply again, the same as new members would do during a revision year. If you are over 16, baptised and consider yourself a regular member of one of our 4 churches. You can grab a form at the back of
