Helping Grow a Team!

Last week I announced the exciting news that Josh Openshaw will be joining us in September as a Pioneer Minister.

In addition to Josh's role, we have new roles for a Youth and Children's Ministry Lead and an Associate Minister. The task of filling these roles with the right people is challenging and so this week I want to request your support in helping grow our leadership team here at St Peter's.

The first way you can help is by **praying**, especially for:

- Houses to be found for both Josh and his family, and our new Associate Minister. These need to be homes with space for a home office and meeting area.
- Recruitment of the right people many church leaders are saying how difficult it is to recruit youth and children's workers at the moment, so pray we get good applications. We will soon be advertising the Associate Minister's role nationally, so again pray for the right person to apply.

The second way to help is by **looking** for suitable houses for Josh and his family and also the Associate Minister – by all means send me links to any websites with house details and speak to any of your neighbours who may be thinking of moving and are looking for a quick sale.

The third way you can help is by **sharing** – spread the word! The more we share the details of what is on offer and shout about our fantastic parish, then the greater the chance is that we can find the right people.
