On Fri 9 May, a group of 10 students, Headteacher Daniel Stefanica and 2 teachers from Vasile Parvan School, Barlad, arrived in Bolton for a 5-day educational visit with Good News for Romania.

They enjoyed a wonderful time with amazing weather visiting Smithills Farm, Bolton Market place and also St Peter's Church on Sunday morning where 4 of the young people read prayers and 8 played the hand chimes. This was so different from their Romanian Orthodox Church and they loved it - what a witness it was to them! After church, it was lunch and games at the Parish Centre and a magic show by the amazing Charles Stanford. They also had time relaxing on a number of occasions at Dave and Kath's and even baked cakes! They absolutely loved time at Create Bolton with the talented Joy Kilpatrick, decorating and glazing their own mugs. They visited Bolton Library and Museum and had a brilliant tour guide, Millie. They rode on a double decker bus, visited Conwy Castle, had time on the beach and spent time at TREAD with our wonderful young people and leaders,

enjoying time playing games on the playing field. #### Prayers by Sam Wolstencroft, CAP Centre Manager
