At Thursday night's APCM I made a big announcement, here it is...

I am delighted to announce that Rev Josh Openshaw will be returning to St Peter's in September of this year to join our staff team. Josh is coming to the end of his curacy at Christ Church Davyhulme.

He comes at a time when we continue to explore options for deepening our mission and ministry in the parish and beyond, and we're really excited that he will be part of the life of the team here.

We'll be working with the PCC, Bishop Matthew and the Diocese of Manchester over these next months to explore more of what this looks like, but in the meantime please pray for Josh, his wife Jessica and their young children, Jude and Arthur, as they prepare for the move.



It's exciting news and it's worth highlighting that this appointment comes in addition to the Associate Minister appointment which will be advertised soon. Bishop Matthew will be coming to consult at our PCC meeting on 24 June and I will keep you posted as plans progress. Please keep all this in prayer, together with our recruitment of a Youth and Children's Ministry Lead.


