Wedding Congratulations

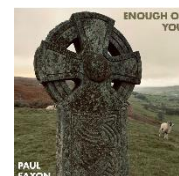


We are delighted to announce the wonderful news that **Jack Shuttleworth and Judith Bower** were married in Smithills Chapel last Saturday (7 June). May God bless

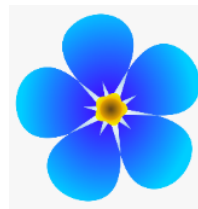
