Rev Alan writes...

I have a saying...

The best organisations have a **vision**, it helps to focus their work and gives a strong sense of purpose and direction. Better organisations have an effective **culture**. Culture is a strong driver to empower and equip every member of an organisation to play their part and pull together for the good of the organisation.

At St Peter's we have a vision: 'Transforming Bolton Together in Jesus' Name' and we have a strong culture as 'Jesus' Family on Jesus' Mission' where everyone has the opportunity to serve and play their part in our worshipping community as we give, meet, serve, baptise and share, and pray. Our verse for the year card reminds us of this.



But there is one thing that eclipses **vision** and eats **culture** for breakfast, do you know what it is?

... It's a move of the Holy Spirit!

We learned on Pentecost Sunday how the power of the Holy Spirit was able to transform the disciples from fearful and in hiding, to bold and proclaiming the wonders of God on the streets of Jerusalem. Filled with the Holy Spirit, their actions resulted in salvation for a huge number of people who became followers of Jesus and led to the birth of the church.

And that power from the Holy Spirit is available to us all today. At our 6.30pm service on Pentecost Sunday, I invited anyone to who wanted to be filled with the Holy Spirit and to be given gifts to raise their hands. I was blown away by the response as

we prayed for lots of people to receive gifts to serve as evangelists, intercessors, the ability to heal, to prophecy and speak God's word, etc. It was exciting to see how God was stirring us up and equipping us for his purposes. I don't believe this was a one-off experience at a special service of Pentecost. I believe God wants to continue stirring us up and equipping us for his service and that, as we are filled, then we will see revival and a realisation of our vision to transform Bolton in ways we could only imagine. Do you believe it too?

If so, let's continue to ask God to send his Holy Spirit on us all as we prepare for greater things to come!

Year 6 Prepare for the Big Move
