# **Mission Matters**



This is our feature on the last Sunday of each month, focussing on stories and updates from our mission partners. This time, we hear from Chandran Jepegnanam of his recent trip to Kijabe.



'I arrived in Nairobi on 30 Mar with all my supplies and didn't have any trouble with them as I entered the country. Thank God. The purpose of my visit was to relieve one of the consultants there to go

back home for a month. My time was spent in clinical work and teaching the resident doctors and non-physician anaesthetists. Friday of the week I arrived, we were preparing for a challenging case, one that I have not been involved in for a long time. That morning my reading was Psalm 144, the first verse, "Praise be to the Lord my Rock, who trains my hands for war, my fingers for battle". This was such encouragement through God's word.

One of my desires on this trip was to get to know the physician anaesthesia residents a bit more. I also was able to hear their stories and their faith. We were able to encourage each other and have agreed to keep each other in prayer.

I have promised them that I will pass on their stories, challenges, prayer requests to those interested in the church and my hope is that people will continue to communicate with individuals and encourage them. If this is something you're interested in, please contact me and I will give you a short bio and means of contacting them. Each of them were really encouraged by the thought that people from church would be interested in them so please give it some thought and prayer and contact me.

Please do continue to pray for the hospital, its work and especially the financial challenges they face due to the non-payment of insurance money due for the work that has been done. This really is a challenge and severely affects the work they do. Also pray for the overseas doctors who are based there, special mention to Dr Greogry Sund and Dr Matt Kynes, the two resident Anaesthesia consultants. There seems to be some moves by the government to discourage overseas professionals by restricting their registration and exorbitantly increasing their professional fees. Please pray that this will not affect the work that is going on. Thank you, Chandran'
