Rev Alan writes...

New Life in Jesus

I've loved working through our latest sermon series *The Challenge of Jesus* as part of our overarching theme this year of *Fix Our Eyes on Jesus*. Through the series we've considered Jesus' teaching and example, which is a just as much a challenge to us today as it was over 2,000 years ago.

The Challenge of Jesus FIX OUR Subsection FIX OUR EYES

Last Sunday, I spoke at St Peter's on the story of Jesus and Nicodemus, a Pharisee who was inquisitive enough to secretly meet Jesus one night to find out more about him. The dialogue between Jesus and Nicodemus is fascinating. Jesus said: **"You must be born again"** (John 3:7). Nicodemus did not understand. So, Jesus explained that the birth he was referring to was a birth from above by means of God's Holy Spirit: **"I tell you the truth, no one can** *enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the Spirit. Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit*" (John 3:5,6). God offers us new life through his Spirit, and Jesus makes it clear that without such a rebirth, a person "cannot enter the kingdom of God."

Being born again is to be created anew – to take us back closer to that original perfect creation in Genesis 2:7. How can we receive this new life? The answer is we simply ask God. Here is a prayer you can use right now or even share it with anyone eager to receive God's new life.

Dear Lord Jesus, I know that I am a sinner, and I ask for Your forgiveness. I believe You died for my sins and rose from the dead. I turn from my sins and invite You to come into my life by your Holy Spirit. I want to trust and follow You as my Lord and Saviour. **In Your Name. Amen.**

Congratulations Rev Roger Oldfield

Last Sunday was a special anniversary for Roger Oldfield as he marked 50 years of ordained ministry. Roger joined St Peter's as a Curate in 1975 and stayed on as Vicar for 23 years from 1980 to 2003, after which he continued as Associate Minister for a further 7 years - a total of 35 years' faithful service
