#### Rev Alan writes...

It's Ouinta! This weekend sees 136 of us, including 112 adults and 24 children, from all our fellowships uniting at Quinta Conference Centre in Shropshire



for a holiday weekend, crammed full of fun, fellowship, great food, worship and inspiring teaching from Bishop Matthew Porter. These weekends are always a wonderful opportunity to relax and deepen and build new friendships. Bishop Matthew will be speaking on the theme of Resilient Faith and it's my prayer that God will use the weekend to strengthen us as his church. I've written a special prayer on the back page of this newsletter. Please note that the only services this Sunday will be a 10.30am parish-wide service at St Peter's with our Area Dean, Simon Cook, and an informal 10.30am service at St Andrew's. There will be no 6.30pm service.

The start of something new! I was thrilled to welcome and pray for Josh Openshaw at our parish-

wide 6.30pm service at St Peter's last Sunday. He preached a fantastic message on the story David dancing in front of the ark of the covenant from 2 Samuel 6:11-23 and it's well worth listening to on our YouTube



channel. At the service, I shared the vision to support Josh in planting a new church in Bolton town centre which will take place in the next year or so. In the meantime, I am really looking forward to working closely with him as part of our parish clergy



team. During his time with us, Josh will be looking to form a churchplanting team – a group of people to be sent from

St Peter's parish as part of the new plant. Josh will also be training in church-planting which should bring us lots of great ideas on ways we can grow our fellowships at St Peter's. His first project will be

taking the lead with our next Alpha course which starts on Thu 25 Sept, 8pm at the Parish Centre; this course will link with the Greater Manchester 'Joinedup Alpha' partnership with other churches across the city-region and is open to anyone seeking to explore faith and grow as a Christian. Josh will be visiting and speaking at all our services over the weeks ahead, so please do give him a warm welcome.



Our parish-wide vision service is now confirmed for Sun 5 Oct, 11am (refreshments from 10am) at St Peter's Church. There will be special Lighthouse United children's Sunday groups at the Parish Centre and a Twinkler's pre-school session in St Peter's Church Lounge. Following the

service, there will be a

Please put the date in your diary and join us for what is sure to be a wonderful opportunity to unite the whole parish in worship and share our vision for the year ahead.
