### Rev Alan writes...

#### All Set for Mission!

I love to say that we are Jesus' Family on Jesus' Mission and I love that one of the exciting things about the mission that we are on is that it takes many forms. It is varied and dynamic, but the aim of our mission is always the same - to share the good news of the Gospel of Jesus Christ by our words and actions! In many of our services this Sunday, we are looking at what it means to be a welcoming and accessible church for people with disabilities; we will be learning from the story of a group of friends who brought a disabled man to Jesus in Luke chapter 5. And next Sunday 5 October is our Parish-Wide Vision Service and, of course, mission will be high on the agenda as we look to our vision for the year ahead. Then, hot on the heels of this, starting on Monday 6 October, will be the Canon Slade High School mission week with the Message Trust. This will be an amazing opportunity for every student in the school to hear about the greatest influencer who ever lived: Jesus Christ. The Message band "Next Chapter" has a fantastic interactive lesson ready to deliver and the climax of the week will be a celebratory concert after school on the Friday. Please pray for this mission week.



Don't forget that our *Parish-Wide Vision Service* at St Peter's next Sunday 5 October is the only service in the parish that day to encourage everyone from all four fellowships to come. Refreshments will be served in church from 10am and the service starts at 11am. There

will be a special **Lighthouse United** session for primary aged children in the Parish Centre and **Twinklers** pre-school children's session in the church Lounge. Following the service, we will all get together in the Parish Centre to enjoy baked potatoes with various tasty fillings, followed by cake and the opportunity to enjoy a social time together. It's the one occasion each year when we gather as one parish so, please do your best to come.

#### **Mission Matters**



This month we hear from Craig and Elaine Watson in their own words:

"We're seeing God grow Holy Trinity, Algiers, here in Algeria. When we arrived, the church was averaging 40 adults and 10 kids and now it is averaging 70 adults and 15 kids. An international church is continually changing so change management and building a sense of community as the body of Christ is critical. Plans to establish an English language school at the suggestion of the Algerian authorities, the BUILD course, and a Christian Muslim dialogue centre are all developing. We need to do work on our 1907 building that has had no attention since being built and has been through numerous wars and conflicts, not to mention earthquakes. We need to maintain good relationships with our Algerian hosts and to put into practice Christ's teaching on being as innocent as doves and please pray that we get our permanent

residency and that it will be for 5 or 10 years. This will avoid lots of time being used up in bureaucracy. Algeria is a wonderful country and we'd welcome visitors from St Peters if



you ever want to come out and see us."
