#### Rev Alan writes...

It was uplifting to worship with everyone in a packed church at our Parish Vision Service last

Sunday - thank you to everyone who came and especially to everyone who served to help make it such a special occasion.

In the service, I reminded everyone of our commitment



as Jesus' Family on Jesus' Mission, to give, serve, meet, baptise and share, and pray — details of these can be found on this year's bible text card, so please get one at any of our services if you haven't already. Following on from this, I asked the question: What's your next step? And considered what's needed to help strengthen our fellowships drawing on our reading from Ephesians 4:11-16 in which the apostle Paul writes about the five-fold ministry of prophets, apostles, pastors, evangelists and teachers. I likened this to the cylinders of an engine and challenged us to consider how God might be calling us into these roles to help the church grow in strength as it fires on all cylinders. Could God be calling you into any of these roles?

Following this, Josh Openshaw gave an encouraging presentation on regeneration plans for Bolton town centre including business and residential building developments which will see hundreds of new homes and a growing population. Into this, Josh is preparing to plant a new church. Watch this space as new opportunities for prayer and ways to support Josh fulfil this vision. at Canon Slade High School in next week's newsletter, but at the time of writing, I am delighted to say that the week has been amazing. Josh, Paul Saxon and I are starting a Youth Alpha course in the school (Room B63) at 3.30pm on Tuesday's.

# **New Sermon Series' Start Sunday**

This Sunday, we start two new sermon series'. In the morning, we continue with our overarching theme this year of Fix Our Eyes in a



series called Jesus with People to help us explore the examples of how Jesus interacted with people... What did he say to them when they were afraid? How did he invite them into his mission? How did he respond to their limitations? We will be instructed by Jesus, the master teacher, and seek to apply everything we learn. We will also examine what Jesus did when the crowds thinned, and he was alone with his Father.



In our Parish-wide 6.30pm services at St Peter's, we start a series called Why Follow? Which focuses on the book of Ephesians. We

ask an old question: "Why?" Why follow Jesus? With so many options to choose from concerning what we may follow in life, why choose to follow Jesus? The book of Ephesians lays out a compelling case for why following Jesus is the only appropriate response to God's decisive action in the world. Paul's letter to the church in Ephesus can be divided into two parts. First, Paul makes sure his readers are certain of what God has done for them in Christ. Second, he moves to help his readers understand how their lives must be reordered to reflect the new foundation Christ offers. The two parts of Paul's letters can be summed up like this: "You have been made alive in Christ; now live!" Why follow Jesus? Because God has made you alive through Jesus and you now have the opportunity to truly live. At today's 6.30pm service, we will also be sharing stories from our Parish weekend at Quinta.

By taking into account worshippers' incomes, the Diocese calculate the appropriate Parish Share we are required pay – this supports the work of ministers across the Diocese, the ongoing education and training of Readers and clergy and other support and development resources.
