Rev Alan writes...

Remembrance Sunday. This Sunday is Remembrance Sunday and at all our morning services we are pausing to remember those who have sacrificed their lives for our freedom. The bible reading at all our services this Sunday morning is John 11:1-37 - it's the story of Jesus raising Lazarus from the dead. In the story we see how Jesus was deeply moved by the death of his dear friend, Lazarus, and the impact this had on the people around. The passage contains the shortest verse in the bible: "Jesus wept" (John 11:35). The story helps us appreciate the depth of God's love for us. As God sees us in pain, he grieves seeing us suffer for the pain of our own sin and rebellion. In spite of us rejecting him and not remaining faithful to him, our pain still pains God. It is a helpful reminder as we recall so much destruction caused by conflicts around the world.
