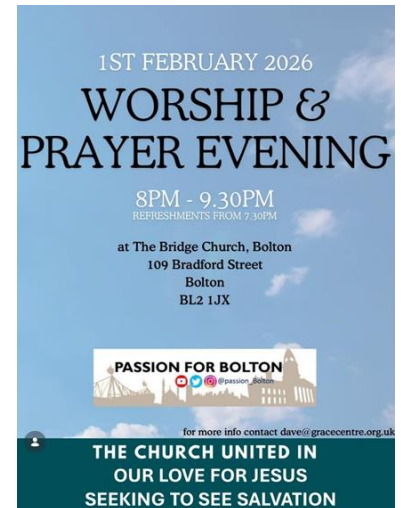

Rev Alan writes...

Let's Unite the Church in Bolton!

On this Sunday evening, we are all invited to join Christians from churches across Bolton for a Worship & Prayer Evening at The Bridge Church, 109 Bradford Street BL2 1JX.

The evening runs from 8pm until 9.30pm, with the café area open for refreshments from 7.30pm. Dave Kruczek, the leader of Grace Church, has taken the initiative to organise this event as he has a God-given passion to unite us all in prayer for the town. It is supported by churches across Bolton as part of the Passion for Bolton church network.



I have taken the decision to cancel our regular 6.30pm parish-wide service to enable everyone to attend what I believe is an important event for us all to support for the town. It's an opportunity for us to unite with our Christian brothers and sisters. Dave Kruczek has asked me to lead a time of communion at the start of the service.

I'd like to encourage you all to join me on Sunday if you possibly can. I believe that when we unite the church in Bolton in prayer and worship, we will see breakthroughs in our mission to reach Bolton for good. Jesus' prayer in the Garden of Gethsemane was that we may be as one, just as he and the father are as one so that the world would know that he was sent to save it (John 17:20). We know from Psalm 133 that God commands a blessing when brothers and sisters dwell together in unity. And of course this echoes our call to love our neighbours.

So, let's unite in prayer and worship in expectation of greater things to come!
