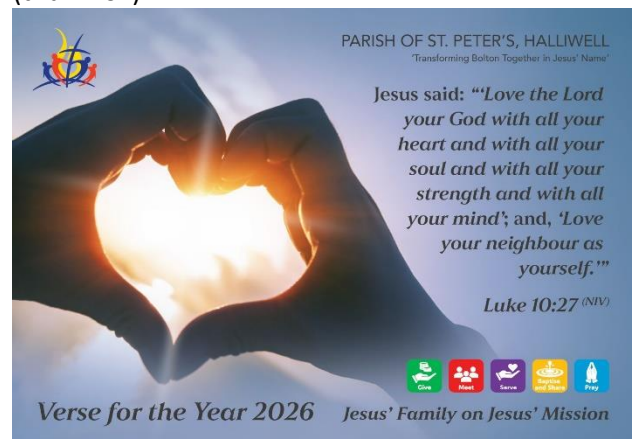

### Rev Alan writes...

#### Happy New Year – Launch of our Verse for the Year 2026

Happy New Year everyone! I hope and pray you enjoyed a wonderful Christmas and New Year. It's good to be back and I am filled with excitement and anticipation for all that God will do amongst us this year. At all our services this Sunday we will be launching our verse for the year 2026, and here it is (drum roll)...



**Jesus said: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind"; and, 'Love your neighbour as yourself.'" Luke 10:27.**

Copies of the verse cards will be available at all our services and from the Parish Office. There are plenty to go around, so please help yourself to extra copies to pass on, or to put up at work, or wherever you wish. On the back of the card is a prayer and details of ways you can commit to church.

The verse comes just before the Parable of the Good Samaritan in Luke's Gospel. Jesus uses this parable to show a teacher of the Law who his neighbour is. Inspired by this story and throughout 2026, I want us to focus on learning more about our neighbours and how we can love them. Our love for our neighbours isn't something we can simply manufacture for ourselves; it comes from our love of God. So, we are starting a new sermon series in our morning services; to help us learn more about what it means to love the Lord our God with all our heart, soul, strength and mind. We will spend a week on each of these themes.

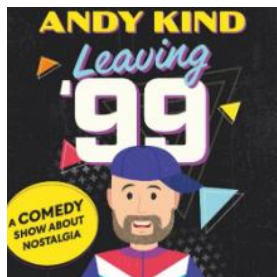
## Do Lunch, Do Life in St Peter's
