It is exciting to welcome the AYF team from Uganda to the parish on Thursday as part of their UK Mission Visit. The group of six arrived from Bristol, having previously visited Peckham and Gillingham in London. They are Andrew, Peter, Mary and younger members: Andrew's children, Elijah and Emily, and Peter's son, Jesse.



The mission visit will include sessions at Canon Slade High School, working with a Year 8 form on the 'Love Your Neighbour' project, taking part in a Youth Alpha special lunch club and sharing songs and stories in a music lesson. There will also be visits to Johnson Fold and St Peter's Smithills Dean Primary Schools, and a day at Lowton CE High School to deliver lessons, workshops and assemblies. They will visit our Tread Youth Group on Tuesday evening. This Sunday they will join some of our morning services.

Climax of the visit will be a special parish-wide **Praise Concert at St Peter's on Sunday at 6.30pm**. Please come along and invite your friends and family for what is certain to be a wonderful evening.

Thanksgiving Service

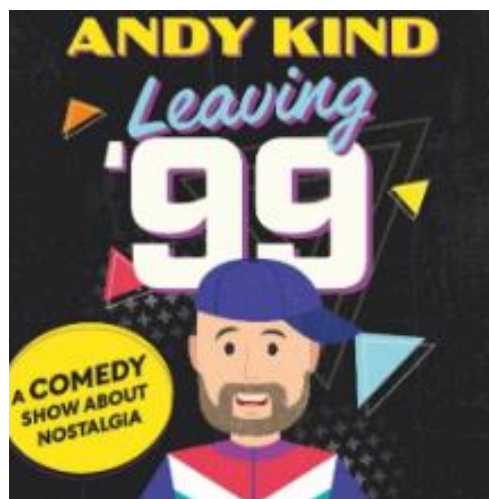
Keith Wills: Fri 30 Jan, 1pm, St Peter's

Mission Matters

This feature on the last Sunday of each month focusses on stories and updates from our mission partners – this month we hear from **Dave Moffoot** from Education India:



"The work of this charity has reached over 40 schools in the last 13 years and our teams have been going out to India for month-long visits, often twice per year. Recently, our team of 4 visited 6 schools, all of which were based in Tamil Nadu, a southerly state known for its temples and architecture. In our morning studies,

we were guided by the principles laid down by 1 John 3:1 "How great is the love the Father has lavished on us that we should be called the children of God". We wanted to demonstrate that love by God's grace to all the leaders, staff and children we encountered. Yes, the days were very long, the humidity and heat exhausting, the 'mosquitoes' annoying but the fellowship and forbearance of so many folk in our schools always makes us realise that our inconveniences are just petty in comparison. We took every opportunity other than the training to share the Gospel with teachers, leaders and children through assemblies, staff devotions and plenty of one-to-one encounters. Most people in the schools are Hindu but the headteachers are always Christian and we spent much of our time encouraging them and praying with them as they often experience hostility from outside. Outside of our visits, we write monthly to the schools and we meet regularly on Zoom to pray for them. Please would you continue to uphold us in prayer."
