### Rev Alan writes...

#### The Movement of God's People



Look at this old photo of St Peter's Church that has recently surfaced on social media, it's believed to have been taken sometime early last century. The church was only 60 or 70 years old having been built in 1840. It makes you realise how much the area has changed in the time since it was taken - this view is obscured by houses now. It got me thinking about what life was like in those days? What must the church have been like? What motivated people to build the church?

Learning from our history is helpful to guide our plans for the future. I've been working on the themes for our sermon series' this year. Last year we '**Fixed our Eyes on Jesus**', the year before we learnt what it means to be church as '**Jesus' family on Jesus' mission**'. This year, I want to learn more about what it means for church to be a **movement** rather than an **institution**.

In a sense, as a parish we have a choice, to either attempt to secure our heritage and ministry as an institutionalised church, or to embrace the pioneering spirit on which the church was founded and discern Jesus' call to continue building a Kingdom movement across Bolton. God has always called His people to lean in the direction of movement, and this has been the call on every generation of the church.

I'll write more as we launch our exciting new sermon series' in next week's newsletter.

### A Circle of Support for women who support and care for husbands / partners with a long-term illness

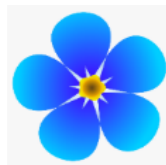
